Warning of a hazard for the user, the unit or possible misuse




Important notice

Safety instructions



Avoid letting liquids enter the device. Never spill any liquid on the device. The product shall not be used in damp or wet locations, next to a bathtub, sink, swimming pool or any other similar conditions.



The 4 push buttons in second row correspond to a unit. Press the appropriate button to select the unit you want to control. The buttons usually carry the same texts as original remote control (exceptions described below - e.g. press "STR" and then use the remote in the same way as the original Stream Box RS remote)

different button markings:

CD

Folder Up - F+

Folder Down - F-

Repe - Repeat

Shuf - Shuffle

STR

F + - F add

F - - F del

Repe - Repeat

Shuf - Shuffle

PREA

arrow up - volume +

arrow down - volume -

arrow left - input -

arrow right - input +

*ON/OFF button only turns Stereo Boxes and Pre Boxes on and off in PREA mode

PRED

Input left : CH-Input right : CH+

Please refer to the device user's manual for detailed description of the buttons. This universal remote includes all the buttons from the original remote control.

Compatible Box Design devices:

PRED: MaiA DS, DS2, DS3; Pre Box DS2, RS, RS2 Digital; DAC Box RS, RS2;

CD: CD Box RS, RS2 T

STR: Stream Box DS net, DS2 T, RS

PREA: Stereo Box DS2, RS; Pre Box DS2 Analogue; Pre Box RS; CD Box DS, DS2, DS2 T, DS3*;



Please note: under PREA only Stereo Boxes and Pre Boxes are turned on and off with the ON/OFF button on the Control it RS.

Replacing batteries

Proceed as follows:

- Unscrew the whole bottom of the remote control
- Replace the batteries. Make sure the batteries are the right way round!
- Reassemble the remote



Do not dispose the batteries as ordinary domestic refuse. Please dispose your exhausted batteries at the appropriate collection sites - usually located at supermarkets and drugstores.
